Campership Grants

The 2002 Campership Grants will be distributed to eligible schools next week at the REE. Schools become eligible for Grants (scholarships) through participation (as soon as there have been 10 delegates from a school). Eligibility to participate in the Grant Program is also dependent upon participation in the REE.

There will be a special table at the REE during Registration and Lunch to distribute the Grant Information Packets which be available for advisers or their designee. Included in the packet will be the new criteria for grant distribution (deadlines and amounts) and the new account forms.

Last summer **over \$5,000** in grants were distributed by SLTP to eligible schools.

This summer we are proud to announce that the final grant total to be in excess of

\$6000.
