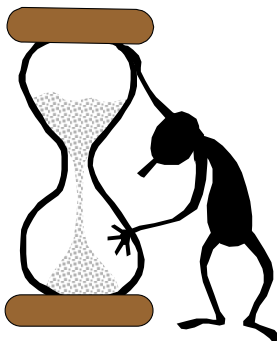
which funds scholarships for inner city youth.
